- 3. Respond to the statement "All of us have value." Is this true? Why or why not?
- 4. Why is it important that Jesus says that loving God and loving our neighbour carry the same authority?
- 5. Read 1 Peter 1:18, 19 again. Knowing that the value of something is based on what someone else is willing to pay for it, what does this passage say about you and others?
- 6. What would it look like for you to place a higher price tag on the lives involved than the position you hold?
- 7. Who is the Holy Spirit inviting you to place a high price tag on? What can you do to see that take place?
